'We can do it! Yes! We promise!'

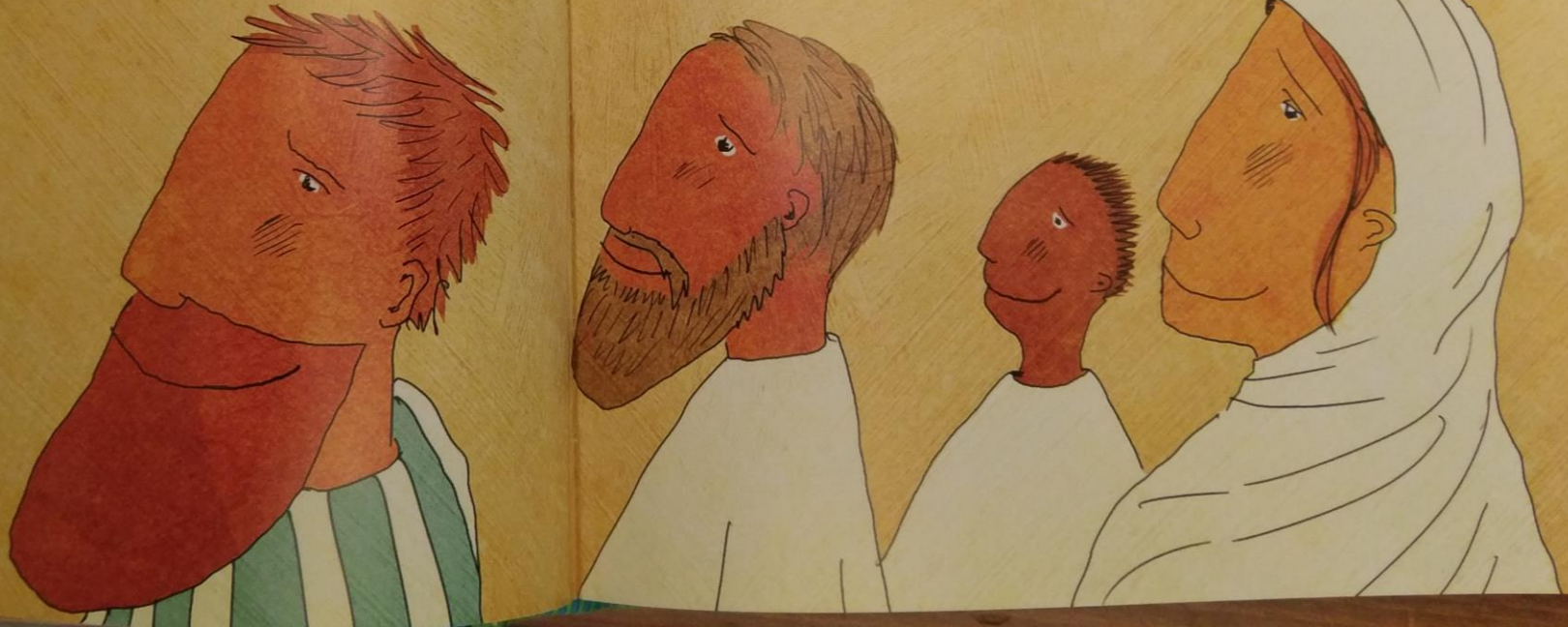


But they were wrong. They couldn't do it. No matter how hard they tried, they could never keep God's rules all the time.
