### ELDERS SHOULD BE ABLE TO TEACH

1 TIM. 3:1-7 ABLE TO TEACH

TITUS 1:5-9; 2:1 ABLE TO GIVE INSTRUCTION IN SOUND DOCTRINE

AND ALSO TO REBUKE THOSE WHO CONTRADICT IT

### ELDERS SHOULD BE ABLE TO TEACH

"Paul's criterion 'able to teach' refers to the ability to communicate and apply the truth of Scripture with clarity, coherence, and fruitfulness.

Those who have this ability handle the scripture with fidelity, and others are edified when they do.

This ability is not limited to public teaching from the pulpit. Men with this ability might be gifted public teachers, or they might simply be gifted for one-on-one or small-group settings.

Some men are not exceptional public speakers, but they are teaching and counselling the people around them from the Scriptures all the time. Such men should not be disqualified from the office of elder."
