

The Secret of Being a Good Follower

Leaving their former aspirations behind




"Go and sell all you have and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me. (Mk.10:21-22)

Leaving their former aspirations behind





Good followers pay the cost of discipleship








God's will is the strongest foundation for life
